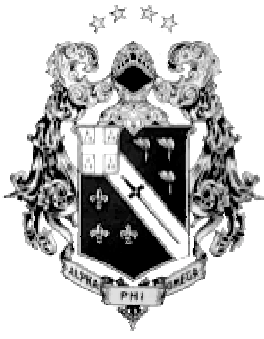
### Scouting for Food

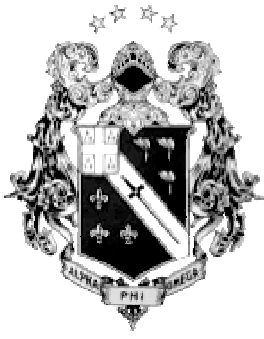

### Annual Potato Drop

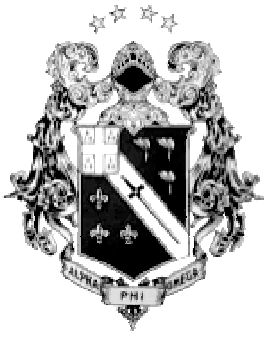

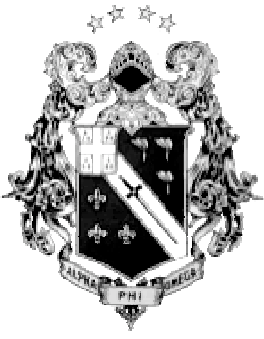
### Heritage Humane Society

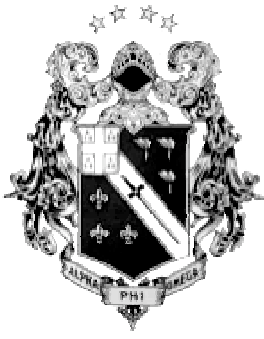

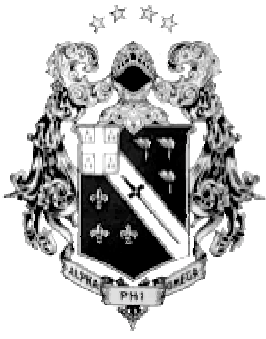

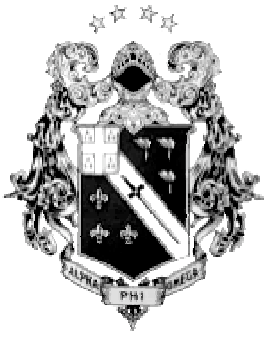
### Condom Drive
