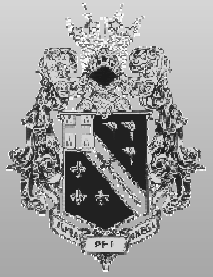

The Campus Kitchen at William & Mary is based off of a national organization with affiliates all around the country.

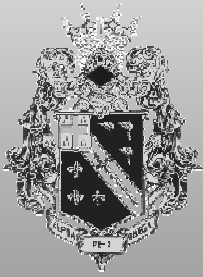
Each has the goal of raising awareness and reducing hunger by taking surplus food from area restaurants and grocery stores and repackaging it as healthy meals for needy populations.

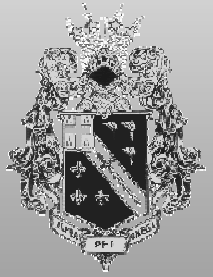

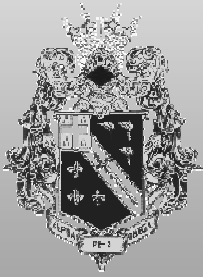
Brotherhood Tutoring

Thus, SHH plans to build a women's academy to support the transition from Copprome to the real world. The academy will support 20-25 girls, providing safe living conditions and an emotional support structure...Through this year's Walkathon, SHH wants to fulfill a promise that it first made two years ago when it fought to keep Copprome's doors open.

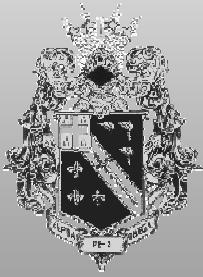
Phoenix Project

 More information to come.

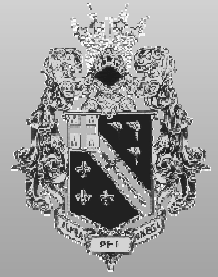

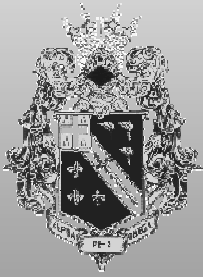

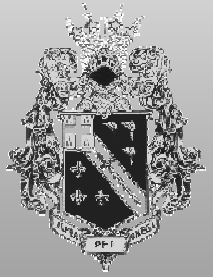
